PRESENTATION FORMATS

Abstracts can be submitted for either oral or poster presentations.

Oral presentations

Oral presentations will be asked to present a verbal presentation at the conference including a PowerPoint presentation.

Poster presentations

Poster presentations will be available via the conference website and app. There will be no live presentation component.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- All submissions must be in English. English is the official conference language, and all presentations must also be in English
- Submission titles must clearly indicate the nature of the presentation
- Submissions must not exceed 250 words, be clear and concise, highlight relevant aspects, findings and conclusions
- References are not required for submissions

IMPORTANT: Please enter submission information carefully, information will be published exactly as submitted.

- Incomplete abstracts or abstracts not written in English cannot be processed and will not be reviewed
- No revisions are possible after the submission deadline no exceptions

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

If accepted into the official program; the following conditions will apply:

- Oral presentations can only be presented by a maximum of two authors
- Presenters must be a listed author on the submission
- Accepted presenters must register and pay to attend the conference, otherwise the abstract will not be included in the official program
- Abstract submissions remain the property of the Australasian Rail Association who reserve the right to publish and distribute

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All abstract submitters are required to agree to the below terms and conditions prior to submitting their work:

- Submitting author hereby commits with the present <u>data protection</u> and privacy policy
- Submitting author declares that the abstract/s submitted are the original work of at least one author/presenter
- All accepted presenters are required to register, pay, attend, and present their material at AusRAIL 2022
- No funding is provided to presenters
- If the submission is selected, consent is provided for the presentation slides (for oral presenters), video, audio recording and photos taken during the oral presentation/poster presentation to be used and published by the Australasian Rail Association including being provided to delegates of AusRAIL 2022
- Submitting author must declare that their work does not conflict with any existing copyright agreements with alternate publishers

- ✓ Presenter photograph
- ✓ Presenter biography

- ✓ Note the deadline and submit well in advance!
